e ormer pro surfer Sean Mattison is riding a wave of good fortune. At 36, he's made an indelible mark in surfing. He has a "wonderful" wife and three kids, who all surf, too. And he has a job for which any surfer would trade an endless summer. "I feel very blessed."

Every morning at 5:30, Mattison goes to work – in the ocean – testing surfboards with his dawn patrol for about three hours. "I'll pass the boards around and get feedback." Then he's off to Surf Ride Boardshops in Oceanside, where he makes his living as a board buyer, and calls in test results. "I deal with the world's best surfboard manufacturers."

It's a win-win for everyone: Board designers get invaluable insight from a surfing pro at no cost (Mattison refuses cash compensation); thanks to his suggested design tweaks,
